OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- **FILLING UP THE POST OF SUB INSPECTOR
(PROOF READER) IN BSF ON DEPUTATION
BASIS**

The Headquarters Director General Border Security Force proposes to fill up two (02) posts of Sub Inspector (Proof Reader) in BSF which is Group 'B' Non-Gazetted, Ministerial, (Combatised), in the Pay Band-2 Rs.9300-34,800/- plus Grade pay Rs.4,200/- (pre-revised) by deputation and for Ex-servicemen by Deputation/Re-employment. The period of deputation will be initially for one year extendable up to three years on year-to-year basis. The incumbent on selection for deputation for above posts will be posted at following BSF institutions where these posts are authorised:-

- i) BSF Academy Tekanpur (Gwalior), Madhya Pradesh
- ii) Training Centre & School, Meru Camp, Hazaribagh, Jharkhand.

2. The eligibility conditions and experience required for the post to fill up by Deputation are as under:-

From amongst Officers of Central Government or State Government or Union territories or semi-Government organisation:-

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or;
(ii) with six years regular service in the Pay Band-1 of Rs.5200-20200/- and Grade Pay Rs.2800/- and;

- (b) Possessing educational qualification and experience as under:-
- (i) Degree or Equivalent from a recognized University Or equivalent with English and Hindi as compulsory or elective subjects.
 - (ii) Three years experience of proof reading from an authorized printing press or Newspaper office and knowledge of printing work.
 - (iii) Must possess medical category SHAPE-1.

For Ex-servicemen

Deputation/Re-employment –

The Armed forces personnel due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having requisite experience and qualifications prescribed shall also be considered. Such persons would be given deputation terms up to the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Force; thereafter they may be continued on re-employment.

Note 1: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Department of the Central Government shall not ordinarily exceed three years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 52 year as on the closing date of receipt of application.

Note 2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on the regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission except where there has been merge of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation.
